



We understand that it is not always easy to estimate your exact pipe, fittings, and valve requirements for a project... **here's what we can do to help...**

ANY GOODS LEFT OVER AT THE END OF YOUR PROJECT CAN BE RETURNED WITH NO RE-STOCKING FEE UP TO 60 DAYS FROM DATE OF INVOICE^{*}

How will this work? Simply...

- 1. Give Waterworks a call to advise of the returns.
- 2. Package the goods including a copy of the original invoice clearly identifying what goods are being returned.
- 3. Arrange a freight provider to transport the goods back to Waterworks.
- 4. Waterworks will arrange a credit.

***Terms and Conditions:** Return freight will be the responsibility of the customer. All goods must be returned in clean, unused, saleable condition. Any unclean fittings returned will incur additional cleaning charges. Returns must include a copy of the original invoice and clearly state what goods have been returned. Goods between 60 & 120 days from date of invoice will have a re-stocking fee of 15% applied. Goods outside 120 days will not be accepted for a credit.
